### **Monarch Condition – Updated Fall 2023**

Rate the condition of the monarch wings



Condition 4: Freshly eclosed Looks like a newly eclosed butterfly. No fading or wing damage.



Condition 2: Fair to Good Little to significant fading, small or significant scratches, but no other wing damage.



Condition 3: Excellent
Perfect with good, rich coloring.
No scratches in orange; pristine.
Small wing rip okay if no scratches.



Condition 1: Poor
Significant tattering, a whole
wing or a piece of a wing missing.
Shredded wings. Extreme fading.

## **Tagging Monarch Butterflies**

#### Male Monarch:



Thin veins and black dots on the top side of the lower wing



Small bump or blemish visible on the 3<sup>rd</sup> vein in side view

#### **Female Monarch:**



Thicker black veins, no black dots



No bump on 3<sup>rd</sup> vein side view

# Where to place the tag





Press and hold tag for 3 seconds then release to secure tag to wing
